

## What did Jesus say?

### *Jn 10; 7,9-10,14-16 (NISV)*

- 7 *Very truly I tell you I am the gate for the sheep.*
- 9 *I am the gate: whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out and find pasture.*
- 10 *The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy I have come that may have life and have it to the full.*
- 11 *I am the good shepherd I know my sheep and my sheep know me –*
- 15 *just as the Father knows me and I know the Father and I lay down my life for my sheep.*
- 16 *I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice and there will be one flock and one shepherd.*

### **Gospel discussion questions:**

- How does a shepherd look after their sheep? Why does Jesus use this example?
- If Jesus was talking today – what examples might he use to describe God's love for us?
- Name some ways we can use this teaching of Jesus in our own lives? For example, how do I look after my friends, my parents, my family?
- What other stories does Jesus use to show God's love for us?
- What other stories does Jesus use to show how we should look after each other?
